FEATURED ARTICLE

A WARRIOR WOMAN

This case highlights the remarkable resilience of a single mother facing significant challenges to provide for her son's special needs.

I was deeply moved during an interview with this woman in her mid-40s who shared her journey. It was a stark reminder of how easily we overlook the blessings and privileges we have in our lives. She began by joyfully recounting the moment her first-born son cried for the first time, but soon her narrative turned into one of tragedy as he fell critically ill shortly after birth, experiencing seizures and developmental delays that persist to this day at the age of 10.

Despite lacking support from her family, including her spouse, this resilient mother has taken it upon herself to provide for her son's basic needs, often leaving him unattended for hours to work as a house help in nearby homes just to ensure they have food and shelter. Financially, she struggles to afford the necessary rehabilitation and medical care her son requires. However, her life took a turn for the better when she discovered an NGO that offers support to children with special needs from socioeconomically disadvantaged backgrounds during the day, providing essential care and rehabilitation services in collaboration with other organizations. Her simple dream is for her son to be able to sit up without assistance, a milestone that would signify victory to her.

Her story serves as a poignant reminder of the countless women like her who are fighting tirelessly to improve the lives of their children with special needs. As I reflect on my involvement in this child's rehabilitation journey, I am filled with gratitude for the basic privileges we often take for granted. Let us never overlook the importance of extending a helping hand to those in need, and always cherish what we have.

COHORT II UPDATE

Eighteen Child Care Institutions (CCIs) registered and participated in the assessment process for PACT's 2nd COHORT program. The evaluation results are currently being finalized.

The announcement of Lok Sabha elections has caused a temporary pause in awarding grants. This means the selection of one CCI to receive a Rs. 250,000 and grants worth Rs. 70000 to be shared by four CCI's will be delayed.

PACT ensured a rigorous evaluation process by appointing qualified personnel:

- Mr. David Istacky from the Good Samaritan Foundation.
- Ms. Usharani, a member of PACT INDIA's governing board.

We will announce the grant recipients once the evaluation process is complete and the election period has concluded.

























HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS QUARTER

- PACT has entered into its 4th year of existence.
- Individualized care plan (ICP) training was offered to 8 CCl's.
- 6 CCI's ICP's were reviewed & plan of actions are drafted for better ICP capturing
- PACT was felicitated by DCPO of Bangalore central for the works on inclusive CCl's
- 8 inclusive CCI's were set up. It is now up and running with the rehab care services in all these CCI's.
- Program ROOTS was redefined which now suits our internal operations by catering in depth services and with extended age group
- 18 children with special needs from 3 different partner CCI's were provided with customized, digitally designed assistive devices through our strategic partner.
- Internship program for students from Holy Cross college, Trichy
 was a great success. Students completed their internship and
 ready to work in different set up where disability rehab would
 be catered. This also includes one student with visual
 impairment.
- PACT was a part of a collaborative consultation to draw 2 CCI's future strategies in Bangalore central's DCPU zone.

NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENT

PACT is honored to collaborate with Amar Seva Sangam, a longstanding advocate for empowering individuals with disabilities since 1981. Their "Valley for the Disabled" initiative is a shining example of promoting inclusion through rehabilitation and social integration. Our collaboration began with the Enabling Inclusion® app, facilitating early interventions for children with disabilities. This innovative tool, after a successful trial, is now a comprehensive support system of PACT, covering assessments in special needs, therapy, and more.

Our journey with Amar Seva Sangam not only enhances services but also imparts profound lessons in humbleness and compassion. This tech based app now tracks the progress of our OAS children with special needs, assists our field specialists manage their interventions, monitors the quality of services provided & takes actions for corrections if any. We express gratitude for this transformative partnership.
